

Inspiring the Next Generation in Science!

ASN volunteer scientists and engineers are back in schools helping teachers with grade 1 to 9 science curriculum topics. We make science understandable, easy to learn, and fun through hands-on experiments and demonstrations.

We've transitioned to the new science curriculum for grades K through 6 and will continue to support the existing grade 7 to 9 units, subject to volunteer availability. We continue to build back our volunteer base after the Covid pause.

Teacher PD workshops for grades K to 6 resumed this year. We are working with School Board Science Support staff to schedule workshops that meet their needs. We are also engaging with the Alberta Regional Professional Development Consortia to support teachers over multiple boards.
